

## **An Introduction to BA of Chinese Language**

Donghua University (formerly China Textile University) founded in 1951, located in Shanghai and adjacent to Hongqiao Economic Development Zone, is a national leading university directly under the Ministry of Education of China. Its characteristic disciplines of Fashion Design, Textile Engineering, International Business, Material Science and Information Technology are at the top level in China and share high reputation domestically and abroad.

Donghua University is an institution of higher learning on the Program of Admitting International Students under Chinese Government Scholarship. She is one of the Chinese universities which first accepted international students in China, beginning to recruit overseas students in 1954. Since then a big batch of international students from over 80 countries have been nurtured and graduated from Donghua University. International Cultural Exchange School of Donghua University is exclusively in charge of recruitment, education and management of international students as well as international cultural and educational exchanges. The total enrolment of international students at Donghua University in 2006 is 1838. Donghua shares a fastest growing rate of the international student enrolment among Chinese universities.

The mission of specialty of BA Chinese Language is to systematically passing on knowledge as well as training for skills of the Chinese Language to the non-native Chinese language speakers, concurrently emphasizing their third language (English or Japanese) learning. The aim of the specialty is to educate and bring up qualified practical talent with strong Chinese language capacity and better understanding of Chinese culture and society in accordance with the needs of international talent market and able to use multi-languages to be engaged in the relevant work. Specialty of BA Chinese Language has now set up three specialized concentrations: Economics and Trade, Tourism Management, Asian-Pacific Comparative Study.

### **Concentration of International Business**

✧ **Education Objectives:** To aim at educating and bringing up high quality practical personnel in international trade with strong Chinese knowledge and synthetic Chinese skills, certain third language capacity, a mastery of basic theory of international economy and trade, and in accordance with economic globalization.

✧ **Main Courses:** Integrated Chinese, Chinese Listening & Speaking, Chinese Reading, Audio-Visual-Oral Chinese Course, Chinese Writing, News Listening, Newspaper Reading, Contemporary Chinese Issues, Foreign Languages (the third language: English or Japanese), Translation from Chinese to Other Languages, Computer-based Chinese Word Processing, Modern Chinese, Chinese Literature, Practical Issues of International Trade, Business Negotiation, Foreign Trade Correspondence, Study of Textile Commodities, Comparison with Chinese and Western in Costume, etc..

✧ **Practice Items:** Including Reports on Reading, Computer-using Chinese Editing, Translation and Interpretation Practice, Internship in Business and Commerce, Graduation Thesis.

✧ **Features of the Concentration:** Shanghai is becoming the center of international economy and trade and has increasingly growing needs for international economics and trade talent. China is the country with the highest production and trade level of textiles and garments in the world. The Yangtze River Delta area represented by Shanghai is not only the major textiles and garments production base but major export base. Being engaged in textiles and garments trade in Shanghai is of great priority and convenience commercially and geographically. The concentration will make full use of university's superiority and lay particular emphasis on textiles and garments trade to educate and nurture talent for textiles and garments international trade based on strong Chinese language capacity.

✧ **Prospective Employment Points:** foreign-funded enterprises, joint venture enterprises, privately owned businesses, trade corporations, etc..

### **Concentration of Tourism Management**

✧ **Education Objectives:** To aim at educating and bringing up high quality practical personnel in tourism management with strong Chinese knowledge and synthetic Chinese skills, certain third language capacity, a mastery of basic theory of tourism management, and in accordance with development orientation of tourism internationalization.

✧ **Main Courses:** Integrated Chinese, Chinese Listening & Speaking, Chinese Reading, Audio-Visual-Oral Chinese Course, Chinese Writing, News Listening, Newspaper Reading, Contemporary Chinese Issues, Foreign Languages (the third language: English or Japanese), Translation from Chinese to Other Languages, Computer-based Chinese Word Processing, Modern Chinese, Chinese Literature, Outline of Tourism, Tourist Resources, Tourist Guide Practice, Exhibition Management, Hotel Management, etc..

✧ **Practice Items:** Including Reports on Reading, Computer-using Chinese Editing, Translation and Interpretation Practice, Internship in Tourism Conduction, Graduation Thesis.

✧ **Features of the Concentration:** As the center of Chinese economy and one of the major tourist cities in China, Shanghai has attracted more attention of the overseas business and tourist people. Its tourist industry presents a broad and promising prospects and its need for the tourist professionals has been increasingly growing. The concentration lays particular emphasis on exploiting tourist resources of the vicinity of Shanghai and the main cities in the Yangtze River Delta area to educate and nurture talent with intercultural communication capacity and ready to provide quality service to foreign guests who come to China to participate in commercial and trade activities as well as tourist sightseeing. At the same time, the concentration requires the students get familiar with the present situation and the future trend of the international tourist

industry, better understand Chinese culture and customs to provide high quality tourist service and management for the Chinese tourists traveling abroad.

✧ **Prospective Employment Points:** various tourist businesses, such as foreign-related hotels, travel agencies, exhibition corporations, tourist spots companies, etc..

### **Concentration of Asian-Pacific Comparative Study**

✧ **Education Objectives:** To aim at educating and bringing up high quality personnel with strong Chinese knowledge, synthetic Chinese skills and certain third language capacity as well as sound foundation in public relations, foreign communications and administrative work, also familiar with the cultures of main Asian-pacific countries.

✧ **Main Courses:** Integrated Chinese, Chinese Listening & Speaking, Chinese Reading, Audio-Visual-Oral Chinese Course, Chinese Writing, News Listening, Newspaper Reading, Contemporary Chinese Issues, Foreign Languages (the third language: English or Japanese), Translation from Chinese to Other Languages, Computer-based Chinese Word Processing, Modern Chinese, Chinese Literature, Public Relations, Asian Pacific Regional Economy, Public Administration, Comparison of Asian Pacific Cultures, Background to Japan, etc..

✧ **Practice Items:** Including Reports on Reading, Computer-using Chinese Editing, Translation and Interpretation Practice, Specialty Internship, Graduation Thesis.

✧ **Features of the Concentration:** As the center of China's economy, Shanghai has had increasingly more international contacts in culture, education, publication, science and technology as well as economy. All kinds of non-trading organizations, institutions and groups regard Shanghai as the platform for them to know contemporary China. This provides a development space for the foreign students who are not only familiar with their own countries' cultures but have a good understanding of Chinese culture. The concentration lays particular emphasis on educating and nurturing administrators of non-trading, non government organizations and foreign-related talent in the area of public relations and administration with sound background knowledge of Asian Pacific culture.

✧ **Prospective Employment Points:** Foreign-funded enterprises, institutions of culture, press, publication, education, various non-government and international organizations etc..

### **\* \* \* Characteristics of the Specialty \* \* \***

**Flexible Schooling Period:** Students can register for either spring or fall semester to start their schooling and can also prolong or shorten the total schooling time within 3 to 6 years according to their own situation.

**Admission Rules:** Students who have never studied Chinese before could apply to start from each Fall semester. Those who applied for starting their studies from higher grades both in Spring and Fall semesters should meet such requirements: having completed more than one year's studies in a Chinese higher institution or an overseas college recognized by the Ministry of Education of China, having obtained corresponding certificates of HSK level, and pass the Entrance Exam offered by the School. Start schooling from the second semester with HSK3, the third semester with HSK4, the fourth semester with HSK5. After having been admitted into the school, the students must take the examinations of the main courses set in the previous semesters and acquire corresponding credits. The examination fee is 150RMB for one credit.

**Up-grading Rules:** A freshman who has got HSK4 certificate and achieved stipulated credits could go up to a high grade. A sophomore who has got HSK6 certificate and achieved stipulated credits could go up to a high grade. A junior who has achieved stipulated credits could go up to a high grade.

**Course exemption Rules:** Those who take the course exemption exams before the start of a new semester and get the score of over 85 for the course exam could share exemption from taking course and simultaneously get the credits of the course.

**The Third Language:** Students can also choose a third language (English or Japanese) to learn besides learning Chinese during the schooling. They are encouraged to take grade or proficiency tests of the third language to strengthen the competitive power for employment.

**Graduation Rules:** The students who have achieved stipulated credits, completed graduation internship, passed graduation thesis defending and got HSK8 certificate are authorized to graduate and conferred certificate of BA degree.

**\* \* Discipline of Fashion Design and Engineering \* \***

**Features of the Discipline:** The discipline of Fashion Design and Engineering of Donghua University is the only one national key discipline in the apparel technology in China with domestically first class, internationally renowned standing. It is the first discipline of this kind which is devoted to fostering special talent for fashion design and engineering. Fashion Institute and Art Design College of Donghua University to which the discipline is subordinate is authorized to offer three level degrees of bachelor's, master's, and doctorate. Bachelor degree graduates from the discipline of Fashion Design and Engineering are accredited with qualification by Royal British Institute of Textile to be automatically members of the World Textile Institute.

**Present Faculty:** The Institute has got a total of faculty and staff of 126, with 15 full professor and 44 associate professors. It has owned a batch of famous experts and designers such as One of Ten Best Designers in China . Eight world top designers such as Gianfranco Ferre, Vittorio Missoni, Olivier Lapidus, Deniel Tribouillard, Sonia Rykiel and so on are engaged as consultative professors of the institute.

**Academic Achievements:** The Institute has been quite active in the arena of fashion design. In recent years, it has won awards of national and international major designing contests for more than 200 person-times. For instance, it once won the Design Award of UNESCO respectively in 1996 and 1999; Tokyo Major Asia Fashion Design Award in 1995 and 1996. In 1998, as a mere representative from China, the Institute of Donghua University co-initiated the International Foundation of Fashion Institutes of Technology together with other 24 famous fashion institutes from 14 countries including the US, Britain, France and so on, taking the position of Managing Director and Vice Chair. The institute also hosts Fashion Culture Forum named Donghua Fashion Week each year since the year of 1995, which is an important component part and highlight of the annual Shanghai International Fashion Culture Festival.

**International Cooperation:** The Institute has established close cooperative relationships with major domestic and international organizations or enterprises such as EU, Japan 's Wacoal , China 's Hengyuanxiang Group, America 's Dupon Company, Japan 's Tory, etc. It has had academic cooperative relations with many universities in the world, such as Fashion Institute of Technology in New York , Media Institute in Hamburg Germany , Bunka University in Japan, ESMOD Fashion Institute in France , Kokkola University in Finland , Manchester University in Britain , London Royal Art College , Hong Kong Polytechnic University , etc.

#### **\* \* Management Discipline \* \***

**Features of the Discipline:** The discipline of management was initiated in 1953. The faculty at that time included Prof. Zhou Shiqiou, doctor of Public Administration of Harvard University, Dr, Zhang Qichun and Dr. Tang Ying. They were China 's first generation of management experts. The present dean of School of Business and Management of

Donghua University is Prof. Li Wuwei, a well-known economist in China . School of Business and Management is authorized to offer three level degrees of bachelor's, master's, and doctorate, which is devoted to fostering high level management talent with sound foundation of economics, proficiency of foreign languages and good at application of IT technology.

**Present Faculty:** The school has got a total of faculty and staff of 122, with 20 full professors and near 40 associate professors. They have taken many important research projects including those from National Funds for Natural Science, National Funds for Social Science, Ministry of Education Funds for Liberal Arts and Social Science, and from provinces and ministries.

**Academic Achievements:** In recent five years, School of Business and Management has won 10 international awards, 94 national awards and 42 Shanghai municipal awards. It has achieved excellent results in the four successive annual competitions of "Challenge Cup of China's Nationwide University Students Pioneering Work Schemes", awarded a total of 4 gold medals, 3 silver medals, and 2 copper medals. In the four successive competitions of Shanghai 's Pioneering Work Schemes, it won 2 gold medals, 4 silver medals, and 3 copper medals. It won second place in Asia area and eighth place in the world in 28<sup>th</sup> ACM International University Students Program Design Contest. It won the champion and gold medal of China 's First Individual E-commerce Contest.

**International Cooperation:** School of Business and Management has established cooperative relations with famous enterprises such as IBM, Glorious-sun Group and etc. to do combined education and set up practice and internship bases. It has set cooperative education programs with Carleton University in Canada , Boston University in the U.S. , Saint Joseph 's University in the U.S. and Lingnan University in Hongkong. It has signed agreements and/or memorandums of understanding and set up academic relationships with America 's Harvard University , Auburn University , Canada 's University of Victoria , Japan 's Osaka City University , Yokohama University , Germany 's University of Applied Sciences Lausitz , Australia 's Macquarie University as well as universities in Hong Kong and Taiwan . \* \*

### **Discipline of Textile Engineering \* \***

**Features of the Discipline:** The Discipline of Textile Engineering was set up in 1951, which is a national key discipline. It is a traditional distinctive discipline of Donghua University with sound academic strength, the general strength of which is in the leading position among the disciplines of the same kind home and abroad. The Discipline of Textile Engineering is authorized to offer three level degrees of bachelor's, master's, and doctorate. It also has post doctoral programs.

**Present Faculty:** The College of Textile to which the discipline is subordinate has got a total of faculty and staff of 126, with 20 PhD supervisors, 24 full professors and 39 associate professors or senior engineers. It has undertaken a number of important

research projects including those from National Funds for Natural Science, national key task projects, provincial and ministry level key task projects, and national new trails blazing projectors over the years.

**Academic Achievements:** In the past three years, the number of annual academic papers published by the College of Textile which are taken down and recorded by the world's three major recording systems of SCI, EI, ISTP has been in the first place among all the same kind colleges or universities in the world. Donghua University has been continuously included in the Yearly 100 Best PhD Dissertations of the Nation over the passed 3 years. Seven PhD dissertations have been awarded the Prize of Shanghai Excellent PhD Dissertation. Doctorates of the College of Textile have published 207 academic papers in the key journals and applied for 14 patents, 8 of which have been entitled to.

**International Cooperation:** College of Textile has established close relationships in academic and personnel exchanges and cooperation with a number of famous textile-based universities around the world. In May 2004 College of Textile was committed by the World Textile Institute to host the 83<sup>rd</sup> World Textile Conference. More than 900 scholars, experts and entrepreneurs from 40 countries of the world attended the grand meeting. In the November 2006, an important event of The International Academic Forum by PhD students of Textile Science and Engineering happened here at Donghua. In 2007, College of Textile will host Annual Conference of Fiber Society, another influential major meeting in the world textile field.

### \* \* Discipline of Material Engineering \* \*

**Features of the Discipline:** The Discipline of Material Engineering was set up in 1954, which is a national key discipline. It is authorized to offer three level degrees of bachelor's, master's, and doctorate and also has post doctoral programs.

**Present Faculty:** The College of Material Science and Engineering to which the discipline is subordinate has got a total of 200 faculty and staff, with 8 consultant professors, 20 PhD supervisors, and 27 full professors. It has undertaken over 500 various research projects over the years and won over 10 national science and technology awards, over 40 provincial, municipal and ministry level awards. Faculty of the college have published over 1000 academic papers in the past five years, about 150 of which are taken down and recorded by the world's three major recording systems of SCI, EI, ISTP.

**Academic Achievements:** Awards achieved recently include National 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize for Advancement of Science and Technology, National 1<sup>st</sup> Prize for Advancement of Science and Technology with Nomination by the Ministry of Education, Shanghai Municipal 1<sup>st</sup> Prize for the New Type and Practical Patents with Evaluation of the Creation and Invention Patents, Annual Ten Major Scientific Achievements of All Universities in China for the last three successive years, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize of China Textile Industrial Association for

Advancement of Science and Technology, and Praise Award for Contribution to China's First Manned Space Flight.

**International Cooperation:** College of Material Science and Engineering has established long term and stable cooperative relations with over 30 foreign universities, research institutes, and transnational corporations.

**\* \* Discipline of Information Technology \* \***

**Features of the Discipline:** The Discipline of Information Technology is authorized to offer three level degrees of bachelor's, master's, and doctorate and also has post doctoral programs. **Present Faculty:** The College of Information Science and Technology to which the discipline is subordinate has got a total of 120 faculty and staff, with 2 specially-engaged professors, 16 PhD supervisors, and 25 full professors and 41 associate professors.

**Academic Achievements:** It has undertaken over 30 national, provincial and ministry level research projects in the previous years. Faculty of the college have published over 700 academic papers, over 10 academic books, and applied for and been approved about 50 national creation and invention patents and new type and practical patents in the past years. The students of the college have won quite a few major national or international awards in the disciplinary competitions for university students.

**International Cooperation:** College of Information Science and Technology has established extensive cooperative relations with some famous corporations, such as America's Oracle, Microsoft, SYBASE, Japan's National, Nitta, Austria's B&R, etc. The way of cooperation includes setting up training centers and united labs. It has also had cooperative relationships with America's University of Michigan, University of Maryland, State University of Louisiana, University of Texas, Japan's Tokyo University, Nagoya University, Britain's University of Leeds, Australia's Queensland University, University of New South Wales as well as Hong Kong's Polytechnic University, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, City University and so on.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Chinese Government Scholarship scheme was established by the Ministry of Education of China (hereinafter referred to as MOEC) in accordance with educational exchange agreements or understandings reached between the Chinese government and the governments of other countries, educational organ, institutions and relevant international organizations to provide full scholarship and partial scholarship to international students and scholars. China Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as CSC) administers the recruitment of international students and the routine management of the Chinese Government Scholarship scheme.

Remedial Chinese language studies are arranged before major studies. If the courses for doctoral and master degree students could be conducted in English, remedial Chinese study will not be arranged. Duration for scholarship specified at the time of admission could NOT be extended in principle.

#### Application

The applicants may apply to Chinese diplomatic missions or the competent authorities in their home country between January and April every year. Applicants may refer to the relevant authorities for details.

#### Eligibility

1. Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals in good health.
2. Education background and age limit:
  - Applicants for undergraduate studies must have completed senior high school with good grade and be under the age of 25.
  - Applicants for master degree studies must have bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35.
  - Applicants for Doctoral degree studies must have master's degree and be under the age of 40.
  - Chinese language students must have finished senior high school and be under the age of 35, will pursue the major of Chinese language in China.
  - General scholar candidates must have completed at least two years of undergraduate

studies and be under the age of 45, may pursue all majors besides Chinese language.

-Senior scholar candidates must have master or higher degree or hold academic titles of associate professor or higher, and be under the age of 50.

#### Details of the Scholarship

##### 1. Full scholarship:

-Exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fee for laboratory experiment, fee for internship, fee for basic learning materials and accommodation;

-Living allowance and a one-off settlement subsidy;

-Fee for outpatient medical service, Comprehensive Medical Insurance and Benefit Plan for International Students in China;

-A hard-seat train ticket between the port of entry on registration or the port of departure on graduation and the city where the host university or the university of Chinese language studies is located (a hard-berth train ticket for over-night trip).

Note: 1) Costs of the laboratory experiment or internship that beyond the university's arrangements should be afforded by the student himself.

##### 2) Scholarship students who have to suspend their education for reason of illness should:

-Return to their home country for further treatment and rest;

-The international travel expenses of return and coming back should be shouldered by the students themselves;

-The scholarship status will be reserved for at most one year;

-The monthly living allowance will be stopped during the suspension of education;

-The scholarship of the students who suspend their education for reasons other than illness will be terminated.

##### 3) Monthly living allowance is paid to the students by the host institution at the following

rates (CNY yuan per month):

-Undergraduates: CNY 800 yuan

-Chinese language students: CNY 800 yuan

-Master degree students, general scholars: CNY 1,100 yuan

-Doctoral degree students, senior scholars: CNY 1,400 yuan

Scholarship students shall get their monthly living allowance from the date of registration. Those who register before 15th (15th included) of the registration month will get the living allowance of a full month, and those who register after 15th will get that of a half month. Scholarship of the graduates will be paid half month after their graduation date. Scholarship of those who suspend or quit their studies will be stopped from the following month. Monthly living allowance will be paid during Chinese national holidays. Scholarship students who do not get the monthly living allowance during holidays can get reimbursed on return. Monthly living allowance of the scholarship students who do not register on time or stay away from university up to one month because of non-health reasons will be stopped.

4) Fee for outpatient medical service refers to the outpatient expense generated in the institution's hospital or the hospitals appointed by the institution. The students should afford a certain percentage of expense in accordance with the institution's relevant regulations.

5) Comprehensive Medical Insurance and Benefit Plan for International Students in China is insured by the MOEC for the scholarship students in China against diseases and accidents. The institution is entitled to ask for compensation on the payment receipts from the insurance company for the expenses generated from hospitalizing for serious diseases or from accidental injury according to the stipulated insurance articles.

6) A one-off settlement subsidy after registration

-CNY 300 yuan for new students whose period of studies in China lasts up to six months

-CNY 600 yuan for new students whose period of studies in China lasts one academic year or more

7)A one-off inter-city travel ticket (each for coming-in and leaving China)

Scholarship students are supposed to choose the nearest port to their admitting institutions for inter-city travel and a hard-seat train ticket (hard-berth train ticket for overnight trip) will be provided to:

-Freshmen transfer from the port of entry to the city where the admitting institution is located

-Students finishing study in China transfer from the city where the institution is located to the nearest port for departure

Expenses for food during the trip and excess of baggage should be self-afforded.

8)International travel expenses

MOEC will provide the international students round-trip or one-way international air ticket based on the reached agreements, and entrust CSC to take charge of booking the most doable and economical international air ticket for the students between Beijing and their capitals. If the students take other line come to China or return back to their home country, they should afford the extra expenses as well as the excess of baggage.

2.Partial scholarship

One or some items of the full scholarship (one-off settlement subsidy and one-off inter-city travel allowance not included).

Application Materials

The applicants must fill in and provide the following materials truly and correctly (in duplicate).

1.Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship(printed by CSC), one original and one photocopy, in Chinese or in English.

2.Highest diploma (notarized photocopy). If applicants are university students or already employed, they should also provide documents of being university students or on-post employees. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.

3.Applicants for undergraduate studies are required to provide notarized copy of senior high school transcripts. Applicants for other categories of studies also need to provide relevant notarized transcripts. Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English

must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.

4. A study or research plan in Chinese or in English (no less than 200 words for undergraduates, no less than 400 words for scholars, no less than 500 words for postgraduates).

5. Applicants overseas for master or doctoral degree studies and senior scholars must submit two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by professors or associate professors. Applicants who apply in China for master or doctoral degree studies must submit the Admission Notice of the targeted university.

6. Applicants for music are requested to submit one cassette recording of the applicants' own work. Applicants for fine arts must submit six color photographs of personal works (two sketches, two color paintings and two other works).

7. Applicants under the age of 18 should submit the legal documents of their legal guardians in China.

8. Photocopy of Foreigner Physical Examination Form (printed by Chinese quarantine authority and only for those whose period of studies in China lasts up to six months) filled in English. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. The medical examination results will be valid for 6 months. All applicants are kindly requested to take this factor into consideration while determining the time to take the medical examination.

The above materials should reach CSC by April 30th 2007 via either the Chinese diplomatic missions in the applicant's home country or the embassy of the applicant's home country in China. CSC does not accept individual applications. Application materials will not be returned regardless of the result of application.

#### Selection of Institutions and Specialty

Applicants may choose 3 institutions and 1 specialty as personal preferences from the Chinese institutions of higher education designated by the MOEC. Please check the Directory of the Chinese Institutions Admitting International Students under Chinese Government Scholarship Programme or the website of CSC (<http://www.csc.edu.cn>) for details. Applicants are required to fill in their preferences of institutions and specialties strictly within the ones listed in the Directory. Applicants for master or doctoral degree studies and senior scholars are required to submit their detailed study or research plan with other application materials.

## Approval and Notification

1.CSC will review all the application materials from the appointed authorities and CSC is authorized to make necessary adjustments on the applied institutions, specialties and duration of study. The qualified applications will be forwarded to different institutions and the final decision whether to admit the applicants or not will be made by them. The application will be seen as invalid and will not be processed if the applicants are not qualified or the application materials are inconsistent with the recruitment regulations or are incomplete.

2.Overseas applicants for degree programs who are academically ineligible to the program could register as students-on-probation for at most one year. They could be switched to regular ones if they pass the entrance examination or relevant courses required after one-year probation. Credits scored on probation will be included in the total credits. Students who attend Chinese language training courses before major studies must pass the entrance examination or relevant courses required during their Chinese study so that to continue their major studies. Those who fail the required examinations shall end their study and leave for their home country.

3.Applicants are encouraged to contact the institutions (115 institutions specified by MOEC listed in the Directory) and tutors prior to application and please enclose the relevant admission or recommendation letter if there is.

4.Scholarship applicants accepted by Chinese institutions of higher education will be officially approved as Chinese Government Scholarship students with endorsement from the MOEC.

5.Students are not permitted, in principle, to change their specialties, institutions, or the duration of study specified in the Admission Notice after registration.

6.CSC will send the List of Enrolled Students, Admission Notice and Visa Application Form for Study In China (JW201) to the relevant dispatching authorities by July 31, so as to have these documents forwarded to the awardees.
