

[The Main Course]

(1) Short Language Courses: 2-8 weeks, Training in listening, speaking, reading and writing upon the request of the applicants.

(2) Regular Language Courses:

- ① Elementary: 1 year, Intensive reading, listening and speaking, etc.
- ② Intermediate: 1 year, Intensive reading, listening, speaking and writing, etc.
- ③ Advanced: 1 year, Intensive reading, listening, speaking, writing and translation, etc.

(3) Undergraduate: 4 years, Navigation, International Business, Law, Shipping Management, etc. all together 21 specialties.

(4) Postgraduate:

- ① Master's Degree Programs: 3 years, Navigation, International Law etc. 11 specialties.
- ② Doctoral Degree Programs: 3 years, Nautical Science & technology etc. 5 specialties.

(5) General & Senior Scholar Programs: 1 year. All the undergraduate programs are available for the general scholars and all the graduate programs are available for the senior scholars.

Textbooks: Modern Chinese for foreigners published by Beijing Language & Culture University and Beijing University.

Qualifications for Admission]

(1) For Chinese Language Program: Any foreigner who holds a high school diploma or its equivalent, is in good health, aged from 17 to 45 is legible to apply.

(2) For Undergraduate Programs:

- ① Test of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry: Applicants for undergraduates in science, engineering shall take the tests of mathematics, physics and chemistry. The minimum score for admission is 180. Undergraduates in economics, trade or

management shall take part in the test of mathematics. The minimum score for admission is 60.

② Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK): HSK is a standardized test to measure the Chinese proficiency nonnative speakers. Applicants for undergraduates of the majors offered at DMU shall reach Primary C level (level 3).

The university has a Students' Hostel, the costs are as follows:

Single Room (with color TV, Telephone and toilet): US\$8 per day.

(3) Meals (served by the Students' Hostel): Three meals are served, which each costing 2-5 at student's option, total about US\$80 per month.

(1) The applicants for the short courses (2-8 weeks) have to contact with the International Cooperation College and settled all the related matters and they can come to China with (L) visa.

(2) The applicants for the regular courses and undergraduate students should submit the following documents: Application Form, the last diploma and transcript, and physical exam report and two half-length photos of the applicants.
